

CAIRNGORM SNOWSPORTS TOURERS + WALKERS INFORMATION AND GUIDANCE

Cairngorm Mountain welcomes responsible snowsport tourers and walkers. For everyone's safety and enjoyment please ensure that you follow all safety advice, and journey through the ski resort using the marked routes, tourers

When there is good snow cover to protect the ground at Cairngorm, touring tickets are available for 2 surface lifts to the upper mountain. The touring pass is available to purchase at the ticket office, which includes your car parking. Outside the ski area these mountains are designated for their unique habitats. Vegetation and thin soils are easily damaged, (boot damage can last over a century!). Please stay on the snow whenever you can and if this is not possible you should follow existing paths. This will help safeguard the Cairngorm Plateau. You can find more information on our website.

FOR YOUR SAFETY



Follow either the marked walkers (brown route), or designated touring route (orange markers), do not ascend up pistes.



Pay attention to warning signs and stay out of roped areas.



Be aware of downhill skiers / snowboarders who have right of way.



Avoid travelling across or up pistes, or lift tracks on ski or foot.



Stay clear of grooming machines, they operate 24 hours a day and can have long cables attached.



Dogs are not allowed on pistes during winter operations.



When transiting through a ski centre, owners are asked to use the identified winter walker routes and to keep their dogs in close control and on a lead.



Please dispose of plastic dog waste bags responsibly
