

# GLENCOE SNOWSPORTS TOURERS + WALKERS INFORMATION AND GUIDANCE

Glencoe Mountain welcomes responsible snowsport tourers and walkers. For everyone's safety and enjoyment please ensure that you journey through the ski resort using the marked routes and follow all safety advice.

Ski-tourers, splitboarders and walking groups please journey through the ski area using the marked routes. Please keep to the sides of pistes and be watchful for downhill traffic. A Chairlift Pass can be purchased from the ticket office, this pass provides a return trip on the Access Chairlift. Walkers may not use any other uplift on the mountain. Ski tourers & splitboarders can access additional uplift by purchasing a day snowsports pass which includes use of the Access Chairlift.

## FOR YOUR SAFETY



Follow either the marked walkers (brown route), or designated touring route (orange markers), do not ascend up pistes.



Pay attention to warning signs and stay out of roped areas.



Be aware of downhill skiers / snowboarders who have right of way.



Avoid travelling across or up pistes, or lift tracks on ski or foot.



Stay clear of grooming machines, they operate 24 hours a day and can have long cables attached.



Dogs are not allowed on pistes during winter operations.



When transiting through a ski centre, owners are asked to use the identified winter walker routes and to keep their dogs in close control and on a lead.



Please dispose of plastic dog waste bags responsibly
